We are committed to the establishment of measurable objectives, targets and plans to ensure the continual improvement of our work health and safety management system that meets the requirements of ISO 45001, and to work towards the elimination of work related injury and illness.

- Providing a safe workplace, equipment and systems of work.
- Provide, maintain, review and continually improve policies, procedures and instructions to ensure safe systems of work.
- Provide information, instruction, training and supervision to all employees, contractors, clients and visitors to ensure their safety.
- Consult and effectively communicate with all employees and other stakeholders in respect to work health and safety in the workplace.
- Compliance with relevant WHS Laws, Regulations, Codes of Practice, Guidelines, Australian Standards and other requirements to which the organisation subscribes.

Management, employees and contractors must all:

- Comply with all WHS policies, procedures and instructions.
- Report all hazards, incidents and accidents.
- Work and cooperate with the Company in meeting relevant statutory requirements.
- Ensure that we work within these requirements so that we do not expose ourselves or others working with or around us to situations likely to cause injury or illness.
